

Separate to these conferences, open houses and events also enable GNC to fulfill its responsibility pursuant to section 200.6 of the Regulations of the Commissioner to provide parent counseling and training for the purpose of enabling parents to perform appropriate follow-up intervention activities at home. Through group presentation as well as the opportunity to meet with instructional and related services staff, parents are provided with information about child development and the needs of their child.

The Board also recognizes that parents/guardians have a responsibility and strongly encourages parents/guardians and other stakeholders to support and encourage their child's career in school through the following actions:

1. Require that students comply with district policies and school rules and regulations and accept responsibility for their behavior.
2. Send students to school with proper attention to their health, personal cleanliness and dress.
3. Maintain an active interest in the student's daily work and provide appropriate supervision for completion of assigned homework.
4. Read, sign and return promptly all communications from school, when requested.
5. Attend conferences for the exchange of information on the student's progress in school.
6. Participate in school activities and special functions.
